### **Unique Item of the Month**

We have another surprise that came through our donation door! This beautiful piece is a very rare creation from an art studio called Luna Garcia. Luna Garcia was created in 1979 by two artists named Cindy and Curtis Ripley, and was based out of Venice, CA. They stopped production in 2015, and their pieces went on to become coveted collectors' items. This ceramic bowl has a unique, bronze glaze that is not commonly found amongst their work and has an official signature underneath. There is only one similar peice found online that is listed for \$900.
