Our new facility brings so many new opportunities to provide our dignified, life-changing services to even more people.

Our Marketplace Food Shelf was thoughtfully designed to resemble a small grocery store. Our choice model adds to that feel by allowing participants to choose what they like and what fits their dietary needs from a variety of fresh, healthy foods.

Our Housing Programs continue to support families who need help avoiding eviction and regaining stability, as well as those transitioning into stable housing from shelters.

Kids are still top of mind. The new space will better provide for them with our beloved Children's Programs: Birthday Gift Room, Back-to-School Success Program, Holiday Toy Shoppe.

Our Shop for Change Thrift Shop is open to the public and boasts a bigger selection, better layout, and the same high quality and uniquely low prices shoppers love.

Visitors to PRISM will also find old favorites such as our Free Library and Free Shelf.

Our relocation began with an offer from Jewish Family and Children's Service of Minneapolis to join them in their new forever home, which was generously donated to JFCS by the Stillman Family Foundation. With a commitment to helping those in need and a desire to address hunger insecurity, JFCS and the Foundation recognized PRISM's services as a perfect complement to JFCS' programs. Our co-location now allows participants of both organizations to more easily access an array of services, and opportunities for collaboration abound.

The list of people to which we owe a debt of gratitude for making this move possible is endless. It has truly been a team effort comprised of the most amazing group of staff, partners, volunteers, donors, and participants, all working in concert to bring our vision of the new PRISM to fruition.

We dreamed of a place that would better reflect the quality of our services, and allow us to meet the community's growing need for food, clothing, and housing support...together we're making that happen.

The Shop for Change Thrift Shop's grand opening at 1220 Zane Ave. N. was a huge success! We experienced unprecedented numbers of first-time shoppers, record-breaking sales, and countless compliments.

It's true that the prices in Shop for Change are unrivaled by other thrift stores, and the quality and level of customer service our shoppers experience is top notch. But, our Thrift Shop is more than just a great place to find a fantastic deal. It's a lifeline for our participants; a critical, growing revenue stream for PRISM; and a model social enterprise in the Twin Cities.

Revenue-earning programs like PRISM's Shop for Change help nonprofits diversify their funding sources to meet growing needs and better-sustain themselves over time. Nonprofits are most stable when they are firmly seated on a four-legged funding platform that includes: (1) donations from individuals, corporations, and community groups; (2) foundation grants; (3) government contracts/grants; and (4) earned income.

We recently received two grants from MACC's Social Enterprise Development Network to expand targeted marketing efforts for Shop for Change. Funds supported advertising, promotional materials, signage, and staffing to make the move, grand opening, and future operations a success. These efforts will continue to increase brand awareness, participant referrals, volunteer engagement, and traffic in the store — and improve sales and build long-term sustainabilty for PRISM as a whole.

While Shop for Change has become a true competitor in the local thrift market, it has maintained its connection to PRISM's mission by keeping prices extremely low, and providing more than 250 PRISM families each year with gift certificates to access needed clothing and housewares at no cost. 100% of profits continue to flow directly back into PRISM's programs.
